- 1. A Credentials Committee consisting of representatives of Belgium, Morocco, the Philippines, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic and Venezuela was appointed by the Conference and in conformity with Rule 3 of the Conference Rules of Procedure met for the first time on 11 October 1973, and subsequently on 15 and 17 October 1973.
