CONSIDERATION OF THE ARTICLES OF THE DRAFT INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE PREVENTION OF POLLUTION FROM SHIPS, 1973

Article 2 (5) - Definition of "Ship"

With reference to Article 2 (5) the Committee is invited to note the following texts:

1962 Oil Pollution Convention

"Ship! means any sea-going vessel of any type whatsoever, including floating craft, whether self-propelled or towed by another vessel, making a sea voyage" [and includes hydrofoil boats, air cushion vehicles and submersibles];*

1969 Intervention Convention

- " 'Ship' means:
 - (a) any sea-going vessel of any type whatsoever, and
 - (b) any floating craft, with the exception of an installation or device engaged in the exploration and exploitation of the sea-bed and the ocean floor and the subsoil thereof;"
