CONSIDERATION OF THE ARTICLES OF THE DRAFT INTERNATIONAL
CONVENTION FOR THE PREVENTION OF POLLUTION

Proposed amendment to Article 5

Submitted by France

Replace the second sentence of paragraph (4) by the following:

"If, after such consultation, or otherwise, the Contracting State [establishes] [is satisfied] that the ship does not comply with the Regulations in question, such State [may/shall] for this reason make the ship's entry into its ports and off-shore terminals subject to certain conditions which will guarantee that such entry does not present excessive risks for the marine environment."
