The following are comente on the draft texte of Regulations of the Convention as subnitted to the Conference under documents SOLAS/CONF/4/1 and SOLAS/CONF/4/2.

## SOLAS/CONF/4/1

The United Statea supports inclusion of the new Chapter II bis without ohance in the 1974 Convention. This is a delf-oontained ohapter concerning fire protection for all vescels covered by the Convention. It allowa orderly expanaion of the regulations when new oroas are to be included in the future, such as special purpose vessels, etc. Additionally, the United States supports the concept of self-contained chapters for any future anendrents to the 1974 Safety Convention,

The United States conours in the findinge of the Working Group on revision of SOLAS given in paragraph 24 on paces 6 and 7 of the document SOLAS/CONF/INF. 2. We wish to oaution, howevor, that care must be exeroised in rounding off dinensions now given in the British syoten when convexted to the netric system. There is sone danger that the construction of ships now built to the British systen of dimensions under the existing rules nicht not be permitted when those dinensions are rounded down to the nearest netric equivalent.

## SOLAS/CONF/4/2

The United States finds the proposed reculation chances acceptable as belng necessary for the drawing up of a new convention in accordance with the decisions of the Bighth Assembly.
