FINAL REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

1. The Credentials Committee met on 31 October 1974 to examine and report on the Full Powers for signature of a convention which were submitted prior to the conclusion of the Conference, in accordance with Rule 32 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The Committee examined and found to be in proper order the Full Powers submitted in respect of Representatives of the following States:

3. The persons mentioned in the Full Powers issued by the above-mentioned States have accordingly been found to be vested with authority to sign The International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974, on the date

on which it is opened for signature, 1 November 1974, or on a subsequent date before the treaty is closed to signature.

4. Full Powers received for this purpose after the submission of the present report will be verified by the Secretary-General acting in his capacity as depositary of the Convention.
