## Text of Chapter II-1 as agreed by the Committee

### Addendum

#### Regulation 7 7.

Insert the footnote to paragraph (e) as follows: "Reference is made to the Recommendation on a Standard Method for Establishing Compliance with the Requirements for Cross-Flooding Arrangements in Passenger Ships, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.266(VIII)."

#### 8. Regulation 19

Insert the footnote to the heading of this Regulation as follows: "Reference is made to the Recommendation on Intact Stability for Passenger and Cargo Ships under 100 metres in length, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.167(ES.IV) and Amendments to this Recommendation, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.206(VII)."

#### 9. Regulations 29 and 30

Insert the footnote to the headings of these Regulations as follows: "Reference is made to the Recommendation on Steering Gear for Large Ships, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.210(VII)."

#### 10. Part B

Insert the foomente to the heading of this Part as follows: "Instead of the requirements in this Part, the Regulations on Subdivision of Passenger Ships as an Equivalent to Part B of Chapter II of the 1960 Safety Convention, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.265(VII), may be used in their entirety."
