DRAFT TEXT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA, 1974

Text of Chapter II-2 as agreed by the Committee

Corrigenda

The following changes have to be made to this document:

- 1. Regulation 8
 - Delete the additional sentence to paragraph (a) as set out in item 14.
- 2. Delete the first sentence of paragraph (f) as set out in item 16 and replace paragraph (f) in its entirety by the following:
 - (f) In general, the Administration shall not permit the use of steam as a fire-extinguishing medium in fixed fire-extinguishing systems of new ships. Where the use of steam is permitted by the Administration it shall be used only in restricted areas as an addition to the required fire-extinguishing medium and with the proviso that the boiler or boilers available for supplying steam shall have an evaporation of at least 1 kilogramme of steam per hour for each 0.75 cubic metres (1 pound of steam per hour per 12 cubic feet) of the gross volume of the largest space so protected. The system in the above and all other respects shall be as determined by and to the satisfaction of the Administration.
