Regulation 7 - Stability of Ships in Danaged Condition

1. The following footnote is inserted to paragraph (e):

"Reference is made to the Recommendation on a Standard Method for Establishing Compliance with the Requirements for Cross-Flooding Arrangements in Passenger Ships, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.266(VIII)."

Regulation 19 - Stability Information for Passenger Ships and Cargo Ships

2. The following footnote is inserted to the heading of Regulation 19:

"Reference is made to the Recommendation on Intact Stability for
Passenger and Cargo Ships under 100 metres in length, adopted
by the Organization by Resolution A.167(ES.IV) and Amendments to
this Recommendation, adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.206(VII)."

Regulation 29 - Steering Gear Regulation 30 - Electric and Electrohydraulic Steering Gear

3. The following footnote is inserted to the headings of Regulations 29 and 30:

"Reference is made to the Recommendation on Steering Goar for Large Ships, adopted by the Organization by Resolution $\Lambda.210(VII)$."

Part B - Subdivision and Stability

4. The following footnote is inserted to the heading of Fart B:
"Instead of the requirements in this Part, the Regulations on Subdivision of Passenger Ships as an Equivalent to Part B of Chapter II of the 1960 Safety Convention, adopted by the Organization by Resolution Λ.265(VIII), may be used, if applied, in their entirety."

Part C - Machinery and Electrical Installations

5. The following feetnete is inserted to the heading of Part C:

"Reference is made to the Recommendation on Safety Measures for
Periodically Unattended Machinery Spaces of Cargo Ships Additional
to those normally Considered Necessary for an Attended Machinery Space,
adopted by the Organization by Resolution A.211(VII)."
