UNIVERSAL APPLICATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE SAFETY OF LIFE AT SEA, 1974

THE CONFERENCE,

HAVING CONCLUDED the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974, to up-date the provisions of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1960,

NOTING that the technical requirements of the Convention provide only for the necessary degree of safety,

RECOGNIZING that all human beings on board a ship irrespective of the flag carried should be sure that all necessary provisions in respect of safety are fulfilled,

RECOMMENDS that all Contracting Parties should avoid any reservations in respect of technical regulations when the Convention is being accepted or in future when technical amendments are agreed.
