## Article 2 - new paragraph (c)

This Convention shall not apply in cases of the offences referred to in paragraph 3, committed during the armed conflict as defined in the Geneva Convention, 1949 and its Protocols as mentioned in paragraph 4 of article 1 of the first Protocol of 1977, which provided for the struggle of peoples against colonial domination, foreign occupation and systems of racist regimes in exercise of its right for self-determination as stipulated in the U.N. Charter and the declaration of the principles of international law concerning amicable relations and co-operation among countries, in accordance with the U.N. Charter.
