CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT CONVENTION FOR THE SUPPRESSION OF UNLAWFUL ACTS AGAINST THE SAFETY OF MARITIME NAVIGATION AND THE DRAFT PROTOCOL FOR THE SUPPRESSION OF UNLAWFUL ACTS AGAINST THE SAFETY OF FIXED PLATFORMS LOCATED ON THE CONTINENTAL SHELF

Proposal by the French delegation

Article 7:

Paragraph 3: "Each State Party shall take such measures as may be necessary to establish its jurisdiction over the offences set forth in article 3, paragraph 1, subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), and (g), and also in paragraph 2, subparagraphs (a) and (b), of the same article to the extent that these latter subparagraphs apply to such offences, in cases where the alleged offender is present in its territory and it does not extradite him to any of the States Parties which have established their jurisdiction in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of this article".
