Proposal by Japan

Article 7 - new paragraph

5. Any State Party which establishes jurisdiction pursuant to paragraph 2 of this article shall notify the Secretary-General of the nature and effective date of such jurisdiction. If such Party subsequently rescinds its legislation establishing such jurisdiction, it shall notify the Secretary-General of such rescission.
