## Proposal by Spain

Text of a statement for inclusion in the Final Act

Some delegations were in favour of the inclusion in article 4, paragraph 1, of straits used for international navigation. It was pointed out that it was unnecessary to include them since navigation in such straits was one of the situations envisaged in article 4, paragraph 1, which said: "If the ship is navigating, or its schedule includes navigation, towards waters beyond the territorial sea of a single State". Consequently, the Convention will apply to straits used for international navigation as it does to the rest of the territorial sea of the coastal State.
