## Proposal by Egypt

Add to article 6 a new paragraph which reads as follows:

## "(2Bis):

)

- a) Any State Party may, at the time of signature or ratification, acceptance or approval of this Protocol or accession thereto, enter a reservation with respect to the whole paragraph 2 of this article or any part of it.
- b) Any State Party which has made a reservation in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph, may at any time withdraw that reservation by notification to the Secretary-General".
