BROADCASTS FROM STATIONS OUTSIDE TERRITORIAL WATERS

RESOLUTION A.107(IV) adopted on 28 September 1965

THE ASSEMBLY,

BEARING IN MIND the provisions of Chapter V of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1960,

CONSIDERING

- (a) that the operations of broadcasting stations on board ships outside territorial waters are increasing;
- (b) that such operations are in conflict with the provisions of the Radio Regulations annexed to the International Telecommunication Convention, 1959, and may adversely affect radio communications contributing to the safety of life at sea;
- (c) that an Agreement for the Prevention of Broadcasts transmitted from stations outside Territorial Waters was signed, subject to ratification, by a number of governments at Strasbourg in January 1965,

REQUESTS the Secretary-General to investigate the question of broadcasts from stations outside territorial waters, in conjunction with the International Telecommunication Union and other organizations concerned, and to report to the Assembly through the Maritime Safety Committee.
