RESOLUTION A.109(ES.III)  
adopted on 30 November 1966

THE ASSEMBLY,

NOTING Article 16(i) of the IMCO Convention concerning  
the functions of the Assembly,

NOTING ALSO that the Maritime Safety Committee, at its  
thirteenth session, when adopting a recommendation proposing  
amendments to the International Convention for the Safety of  
Life at Sea, 1960, in respect of fire safety measures for  
existing passenger ships, which amendments have been adopted  
by the Assembly (Annex I of A/ES.III/Res.108), also recommended  
that Governments should act immediately to put the measures  
contained in the proposed amendments into effect, without  
awaiting their entry into force,

ENDORSES the above-mentioned recommendation of the Maritime  
Safety Committee,

INVITES all Governments concerned to put the measures  
recommended in Annex I of A/ES.III/Res.108 into effect, to the  
maximum extent, as soon as possible, without awaiting the entry  
into force of the amendments.
