RELATIONS WITH NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING Part XVI of the Convention on the International Maritime Organization and, in particular Article 67,

BEARING IN MIND the Rules and guidelines for consultative status of non-governmental international organizations with the International Maritime Organization ("the Rules and Guidelines"),

RECALLING that rule 1 of the Rules and Guidelines requires that consultative status granted by the Council to such organizations be subject to approval by the Assembly,

RECALLING ALSO that rule 12 of the same Rules and Guidelines provides for a periodic review by the Council of the list of non-governmental international organizations in consultative status with IMO and for a report to be submitted to the Assembly on the continuation, or otherwise, of such status,

BEARING IN MIND that the International Paint and Printing Ink Council (IPPIC) has changed its name to "World Coatings Council", without an acronym, that the Community of European Shipyards' Associations (CESA) has changed its name to "CESA" only and that NACE International has merged with the Society for Protective Coatings (SSPC) and changed its name to the "Association for Materials Protection and Performance Inc. (AMPP)",

NOTING the decision of the Council, at its thirty-fourth extraordinary session, to grant consultative status to the Ballastwater Equipment Manufacturers' Association (BEMA), Global TestNet, The International Windship Association (IWSA) and The Grain and Feed Trade Association (GAFTA), and to grant consultative status, on a provisional basis, for no more than two years, after which a review should be conducted, to the Inuit Circumpolar Council (ICC),

NOTING ALSO the decision of the Council, at its thirty-fourth extraordinary session, to solicit more active participation of the International Spill Control Organization (ISCO) and the International Water Mist Association (IWMA) in IMO's work,

REAFFIRMING that all non-governmental organizations in consultative status are required to contribute substantially to the work of IMO in their respective fields of work,



1 APPROVES:

- the decision of the Council to grant consultative status to the Ballastwater Equipment Manufacturers' Association (BEMA), Global TestNet, The International Windship Association (IWSA) and The Grain and Feed Trade Association (GAFTA);
- .2 the decision of the Council to grant consultative status, on a provisional basis, for no more than two years, after which a review should be conducted, to the Inuit Circumpolar Council (ICC);
- .3 the decision of the Council to maintain the consultative status of the remaining organizations; and
