THE ASSEMBLY,

Resolution A.12 (I),

RESOLVES that the Maritime Safety Committee elected on
15 January 1959 should now be dissolved,

DECIDES to constitute a new Maritime Safety Committee in
accordance with Article 28 of the Convention as interpreted by
the International Court of Justice in its Advisory Opinion,

DECIDES that the measures taken by the Maritime Safety
Committee in the course of its sessions during the period
1959 to 1961 are hereby adopted and confirmed.
