NOTING FURTHER that at its present session it adopted, by Resolution A.246(VII), amendments to the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution of the Sea by Oil, 1954 concerning tank arrangements and the limitation of tank size from the point of view of minimizing pollution of the sea by oil,

INVITES all governments concerned:

- (a) to make known the provisions of the said amendments to shipowners and operators under their jurisdiction;
- (b) to put into effect the said amendments as soon as possible without awaiting the entry into force of
