RESOLUTION A 370(IX)  
adopted on 14 November 1975

RELATIONS WITH NON-GOVERNMENTAL INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

THE ASSEMBLY,

TAKING NOTE of Part XII of the IMCO Convention and in particular Article 48,

RECALLING that Rule 1 of the Rules Governing Relationship with Non-Governmental International Organizations requires that the Assembly approve consultative status granted by the Council to such organizations,

RECALLING FURTHER that Rule 10 of the same Rules provides for periodic review by the Council of the list of non-governmental international organizations in consultative status with IMCO and a report to the Assembly on the continuation of such status,

HAVING CONSIDERED the request of the Council at its thirty-fourth and eighth extraordinary sessions to approve the grant of consultative status to the following, as bodies which are able to make a substantial contribution to the work of the Organization:
