IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS ON  
TREATMENT OF SHELTER-DECK AND OTHER 'OPEN' SPACES

RESOLUTION A.86(IV)  
adopted on 27 September 1965

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING its Resolution A.48(III) concerning the  
Recommendations on the treatment of shelter-deck and other  
'open' spaces,

TAKING NOTE that, in accordance with the terms of that  
Resolution, the Maritime Safety Committee, at its eighth session,  
approved the details of the tonnage mark table, the form and  
position of the tonnage mark and definition of the uppermost  
and second decks,

HAVING EXAMINED the report of the Maritime Safety Committee  
(MSC X/36, paragraphs 54-56) which was transmitted to the  
Assembly by the Council in accordance with Article 22(a) of  
the IMCO Convention,

BEARING IN MIND the recommendations to governments to  
include in their national tonnage measurement requirements,  
provisions to give effect to the Recommendations,

NOTING that certain countries have already taken steps to  
give effect to the Recommendations,

REQUESTS governments which have not yet implemented those  
Recommendations to give consideration to so doing.
