RESOLUTION A.88(IV)

adopted on 27 September 1965

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING its Resolution A.52(III) concerning the studies of the intact stability of fishing vessels,

HAVING EXAMINED the report of the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC X/36, paragraphs 75-82) which was transmitted to the Assembly by the Council in accordance with Article 22(a) of the IMCO Convention,

NOTING with satisfaction, the establishment of the Panel of Experts on Stability of Fishing Vessels and the work already accomplished,

NOTING FURTHER, with satisfaction, the close co-operation established between the Organization and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations,

REQUESTS the Maritime Safety Committee to continue to ensure that the objective of formulating acceptable standards for the intact stability of fishing vessels is pursued with all possible speed.
