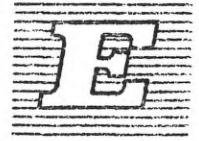

TRAINING OF SEAFARERS

RESOLUTION A.89(IV)
adopted on 27 September 1965

THE ASSEMBLY,

HAVING CONSIDERED the recommendations of the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC X/36, paragraphs 91-94) with regard to the Report of the Joint ILO/IMCO Committee on the Training of Seafarers to which Recommendation 39 of the International Conference on Safety of Life at Sea, 1960, refers,

NOTING that the Report has been adopted by the Governing Body of the International Labour Organisation,

DECIDES:

- (a) to adopt the Report of the Joint Committee;
- (b) to invite the Secretary-General to disseminate to Member States and to States which participated in the International Conference on Safety of Life at Sea, 1960, the "Document for Guidance" (Annex III to the Report of the Joint Committee) which sets out recommendations for the education and training of masters, officers and seamen in the use of aids to navigation, of life-saving appliances and of devices for use in the prevention, detection or extinction of fire.
