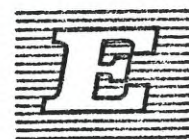

RESOLUTION A.94(IV)
adopted on 27 September 1965

THE ASSEMBLY,

CONSIDERING that the Recommendations of the International Conference on Safety of Life at Sea, 1960, applicable to nuclear ships provide for the development of more detailed requirements for nuclear ships, as and when need arises,

BEARING IN MIND the agreement established between the Organization and the International Atomic Energy Agency,

HAVING EXAMINED the report of the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC X/36, paragraphs 115-121) which was transmitted to the Assembly by the Council in accordance with Article 22(a) of the IMCO Convention,

NOTING with approval the participation of IMCO in the Third International Conference on the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy in September 1964,

REQUESTS the Secretary-General to continue to maintain all necessary co-operation with the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency.
