THE ASSEMBLY,

NOTING IN ADDITION Article 30(b) of the IMCO Convention providing that the Maritime Safety Committee shall report to the Assembly on its work since the previous regular session of the Assembly,

NOTING ALSO that, as provided in Article 22 of the IMCO Convention, the Council at its fourteenth session considered the Report of the Maritime Safety Committee and transmitted it to the Assembly,

HAVING CONSIDERED the Report of the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC X/36),

RECALLING that the Assembly at this session has adopted Resolutions concerning:

- (b) International Code of Signals

- (m) emergency position-indicating radio beacons
