POST ADJUSTMENT FOR THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

RESOLUTION C.24(XIV)
adopted on 18 June 1965

THE COUNCIL,

RECALLING its responsibility under Article 23 of the Convention to determine the terms and conditions of service of the Secretary-General, which terms shall conform as far as possible with those of the United Nations and its Specialized Agencies,

RECALLING FURTHER that IMCO's Staff Regulations provide (Annex I, paragraph 9) for the adjustment of basic salaries by the application of post adjustments, the amounts of which are determined on the basis of relative costs of living, standards of living, and related factors,

NOTING that it is customary for the Executive Head of United Nations Specialized Agencies to be accorded whatever allowances are normally paid to staff and at the rate established for Under-Secretaries of the United Nations, which rate appears in Table "B" of Annex I, paragraph 9, of the Staff Regulations.

FURTHER NOTING that IMCO alone of all the Specialized Agencies excludes post adjustment in the contract of its Executive Head,

COUNCIL XIV/Res.24

DECIDES to amend the contract of the Secretary-General to provide for the payment of post adjustment at the rate established for an Under-Secretary of the United Nations, effective 1 July 1964, the date on which post adjustment was effective for IMCO's staff.
