- (ii) That reports prepared and submitted by committees and subordinate bodies for translation, reproduction and distribution shall be reduced both in number and length to the minimum necessary to inform the membership of the work and decisions or recommendations made by such bodies;
  - (iii) That documents and information transmitted by Member States for circulation by the Organization shall be limited to the briefest length essential to communicate useful information to Members,
2. INSTRUCTS the Secretary-General henceforth to apply strictly the rules on submission of documents prior to meetings as specified in the various rules of procedure and relevant decisions of the committees,
  3. RECOMMENDS that Member States review their need for multiple copies of IMCO documents and advise the Secretariat as soon as possible the minimum number of documents necessary to be sent to each Member State,
  4. RECOMMENDS FURTHER that the number of copies of documentation for meetings of organs and bodies of the Organization circulated by the Secretariat should normally not exceed five copies for each Government,
  5. REQUESTS the Secretary-General to report to the Assembly on the decisions and recommendation contained herein.
