THE COUNCIL,

NOTING resolution A.458(XI) by which the Assembly at its eleventh session voted appropriations for the financial period 1980/81,

NOTING ALSO resolution A.459(XI) by which the Assembly authorized the Council to approve, at its forty-fifth session, any necessary recalculation of the budget and assessment figures for 1981 on the basis of the rate of exchange applicable at the time the Council meets,

1. APPROVES the recalculation of the budget and assessment figures for 1981 on the basis of a rate of exchange of \$2.43 to the pound;

- 2. DECIDES that:
  - (a) The additional budgetary requirement in 1981 of \$1,971,900 resulting from the recalculation approved in paragraph 1 above shall be met by an appropriation in Section V of the IMCO budget and transferred to the Exchange Reserve Fund for disbursement as necessary to meet the effects of movements in the rate of exchange on the 1981 budget;
  - (b) The revised appropriations by sections for 1981 shall be those shown in the Annex to this resolution and shall be financed by contributions from Member States after adjustment as provided in the Financial Regulations; for this purpose miscellaneous income remains at \$211,800;
