THE TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION COMMITTEE,

RECALLING the United Nations System-Wide Medium-Term Plan for Women and Development 1990-1995 (E/1987/52), with particular reference to sub-programme 5.4 "Technical co-operation, training and advisory services", para (v), encouraging identification of the impact of technical co-operation on women so it may become an integral part of the appraisal, monitoring and evaluation of projects,

RECALLING FURTHER the IMO medium term plan for the integration of women in the maritime sector, with particular reference to the policy objectives, encouraging full and systematic integration of women in the maritime sector,

DESIRING to develop ways to enhance implementation of the policy objectives of the IMO medium term plan for the integration of women in the maritime sector,

1. REQUESTS that member Governments submitting requests for funding for technical co-operation projects should include in their proposal an analysis of the project in relation to implementation of the policy objectives of the IMO medium term plan;
2. INVITES prospective donors to bear this analysis in mind when deciding on the allocation of funding between projects;
3. REQUESTS that the Secretariat should monitor such projects during execution and conduct an evaluation on completion to assess the project's contribution to the implementation of the medium term plan.
