Subject: **Illumination of the IMO building and other emblematic landmarks
to mark World Maritime Day on Thursday, 25 September 2025**

The Secretary-General has the honour to announce that, as it has become customary since the initiative was launched in 2021, on the evening of **25 September 2025**, the IMO building and the Seafarer's memorial will be bathed in blue light to promote World Maritime Day.



This initiative to light up in blue colour IMO Headquarters and other emblematic landmarks around the world on World Maritime Day has become a symbol of the effort of the maritime community to raise awareness of the vital contribution of shipping to the world.
