Dear Secretary General:

Re: 'Temporary' formats for New Zealand STCW and STCW-F certificates

In accordance with Article IV-1(c) of the STCW convention and Article 4.1 of the STCW-F convention attached for your records are a number of new specimen certificates issued in compliance to these conventions.

Due to the global impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic, Maritime New Zealand has had to implement alternative arrangements for issuing certificates. New Zealand is currently under a "State of Emergency" and there are strict restrictions, set out by the Government, in regard to working arrangements and travel for workers to avoid the spread of the virus. All Maritime New Zealand staff are required to work from home and are currently unable to access equipment which is used to produce and print STCW and STCW-F certificates in their normal form, i.e. passport type or 'credit card' type format.

From the date of this letter for the period of these emergency restrictions, New Zealand will be issuing any new STCW and STCW-F certificates in the attached temporary format. Any certificates issued in this format are full and valid; it is only the format which is temporary.

Any certificates issued using the temporary format will be replaced as soon as possible, once emergency restrictions are lifted and accessibility to the required facilities and equipment is permitted.

I would appreciate it if you could circulate these documents to IMO member States and observer organizations.
