The Lebanese Ministry of Public Works and Transport, the Directorate General of Land and Maritime Transport would like to express its appreciation for the IMO's commitment and dedication of the rapid response to fight the Covid-19 and its affects in the world maritime sector.

In the light of the ongoing crew change crisis, besides the IMO's Circular Letter No. 4204/Add. 35 dated 14 December 2020 referring in particular to the provisions of:

- 1. MSC. Resolution 473 (ES.2),
- 2. Resolution A/75/L.37, and the ILO
- 3. GB. 340/Resolution (Rev.2).

And as our responses to the pandemic is constantly evolving, the Lebanese Maritime Administration, by taking into account the principles and guidelines issued by IMO and ILO, has taken arrangements as flag state and as port state to facilitate crew changes and access to medical care which allows seafarers to travel, to be in transit to join or to return back home.

We kindly request if this communication could be circulated to the members states and to add LEBANON to the list of countries that have designated seafarers as Key Workers.
