# Supporting Pacific Small Island Developing States to implement IMO measures

### THE ISSUE

Many countries need support to ensure IMO's more than 50 treaties are translated into national law. This is critical for implementation by flag States, port States and coastal States.

### OUR SOLUTION

SMART-C Leaders supports SIDS of the Pacific region to implement IMO instruments. The project will strengthen the capacity of Member States for Port State Control (PSC) and Flag State Implementation (FSI). Countries will receive targeted support to implement their corrective action plans (CAPs) established after their audit under the IMO Member State Audit Scheme (IMSAS). The projects will train public officials who are in charge of implementing IMO conventions and who attend IMO meetings.

### IMPACT

- ✓ Enhancing robust governance and compliance with international maritime standards contained in IMO treaties.
- ✓ Strengthening the capacity and expertise of professionals who are involved in IMO meetings and Port State Control (PSC) and Flag State Implementation (FSI).
- ✓ Facilitating continuous knowledge exchange and ensuring participants receive timely updates on the IMO conventions.
- ✓ Ensuring higher standards of maritime safety through the implementation of the corrective action plan under the IMO Member State Audit Scheme.
