One of the perpetrators advanced aggressively, forcing the watchmen to retreat to the port quarter who then raised the alarm. The officer of the Watch (OOW) immediately notified the Master and crew. The ship attempted to contact the Bangladesh Navy and Port Control but with no response. The OOW then observed the perpetrators fleeing from the starboard quarter in two long wooden boats. A subsequent search confirmed no perpetrators remained onboard, but 2900 litres of assorted paint were stolen. The crew were not injured. The incident has been reported to local authorities as well as Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) (flag State).	2900 litres of assorted paint were stolen. The perpetrator attempted to threaten the engine room watchkeeping staff, who ran away and secured himself in the engine control room. The master was informed and the general alarm was activated.
