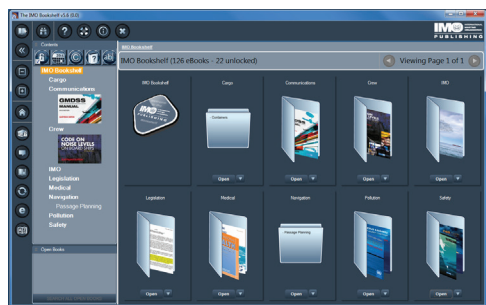


THE IMO BOOKSHELF

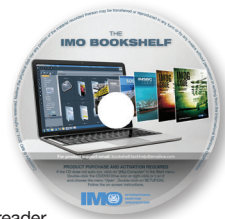
The IMO Bookshelf is IMO Publishing's new e-reader software. E-reader files are available for all major titles in English. They are replicas of the printed title and can be viewed instantly after purchasing a licence code and downloading the software. The IMO Bookshelf enables you to view all your e-reader purchases in one place and search them simultaneously.



E-reader files are presented in EBK format and include the following key features:

- Installation available without internet access
- Multiple advanced search facilities
- Add your own bookmarks
- Add your own annotations
- Resize text
- Printing
- Copy and paste

The software is available in two ways:



1 Free download

from IMO Publishing's website (www.imo.org/publications/pages/bookshelf.aspx). This is the e-reader software only without any of the titles added. Purchased digital titles must also be downloaded and unlocked before they can be viewed.

2 Free CD

which contains the e-reader software and all major e-reader titles available to search and ready for unlocking. Please request a CD from your local distributor or by e-mailing sales@imo.org

Each e-reader title requires activation and is locked to one computer. All unlocking codes can be purchased from your local distributor. Please visit www.imo.org/publications/distributors

IMO requirements on carriage of publications on board ships states that "The publications may be carried in the form of electronic media such as CD-ROM in lieu of hard copies. Acceptable publications in electronic form should be those issued by IMO or an Administration or a body authorized by an Administration to ensure correctness of their contents and to safeguard against illegal copying."

Other IMO digital formats

E-books

An e-book is an exact replica of the printed book in pdf format. E-books are available for smaller titles in English, some model courses and foreign language titles (Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian and Spanish).

E-books are available immediately (after purchase) from IMO Publishing's Virtual Publications site (<http://vp.imo.org>). For licensing purposes the e-book will be stamped with the user's name.

IMO Publishing's e-books can be purchased from your local distributor.

CDs

The key IMO Publishing CDs are available as demos with the option to purchase and activate the product. Once activated, they can be launched without requiring internet access. They have added features such as an advanced search facility and a favourites section. The products include:

- IMDG Code for Windows (also available to download)
- The IMO-Vega Database

Other available CDs include:

- IMO Labels and Symbols
- e-learning: Marine Accident and Incident Investigation

A single licence is computer specific. CDs and additional licences can be purchased from your local distributor who will supply you with an Advance Purchase Code (for the IMDG Code and IMO-Vega CDs) to complete the activation at www.imoactivate.com

Internet subscriptions

IMO Publishing's online subscriptions can be accessed anywhere in the world via the internet. Each title has an advanced search facility to enable you to access information immediately. They are also regularly updated at no extra cost, ensuring the latest information is only a click away.

IMO Publishing's internet subscriptions are available for five key titles:

- IMDG Code
- SOLAS
- SOLAS Plus (including related instruments)
- MARPOL
- IMO-Vega Database

The cost of these subscriptions is per annum, per licence. A licence allows one concurrent user.
