

# Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage

## Supplement

The following amendments of the limitation amounts in the Protocol of 1992 to Amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969 were adopted by the Legal Committee of the International Maritime Organization by resolution LEG.1(82) on 18 October 2000 and entered into force on 1 November 2003.

Article 6(1) of the 1992 CLC Protocol is amended as follows:

the reference to “3 million units of account” shall read “4,510,000 units of account”;

the reference to “420 units of account” shall read “631 units of account”; and

the reference to “59.7 million units of account” shall read “89,770,000 units of account”.

The following amendments of the limits of compensation in the Protocol of 1992 to amend The International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 were adopted by the Legal Committee of the International Maritime Organization by resolution LEG.2(82) on 18 October 2000 and entered into force on 1 November 2003.

Article 6(3) of the 1992 Fund Protocol is amended as follows:

the reference in paragraph 4(a) to “135 million units of account” shall read “203,000,000 units of account”;

the reference in paragraph 4(b) to “135 million units of account” shall read “203,000,000 units of account”; and

the reference in paragraph 4(c) to “200 million units of account” shall read “300,740,000 units of account”.
