Asunto: **Edición inaugural del curso de formación "Liderazgo y empoderamiento de las mujeres que trabajan en el sector marítimo", Malmö (Suecia)**

1 El Secretario General se complace en anunciar que la edición inaugural del curso de formación titulado "Liderazgo y empoderamiento de las mujeres que trabajan en el sector marítimo", patrocinado por la Organización Marítima Internacional (OMI) y la Asociación Internacional de Mujeres en el Sector del Comercio y el Transporte Marítimo (WISTA International), e impartido por la Universidad Marítima Mundial (UMM), se celebrará con un formato híbrido, y constará de tres días de aprendizaje a distancia, seguidos de una semana *in situ* en la UMM de Malmö (Suecia), y otros dos días de aprendizaje a distancia una vez que los participantes hayan regresado a sus respectivos países de origen. A continuación figuran las fechas de las tres fases de formación:

- a. fase A (en línea): del 9 al 11 de septiembre de 2025;
- b. fase B (presencial): del 6 al 10 de octubre de 2025; y
- c. fase C (en línea): días 21 y 22 de octubre de 2025.

2 El objetivo principal de este curso es dotar de aptitudes de liderazgo y gestión estratégica de alto nivel a las mujeres del sector marítimo que se encuentran en mitad de su carrera profesional, para que puedan progresar y asumir funciones decisorias. Este curso está concebido para mujeres que trabajan en el sector público del ámbito marítimo, por ejemplo, en administraciones marítimas, autoridades portuarias, guardacostas e instituciones de educación y formación marítimas. Por otra parte, las mujeres que se dedican al sector privado en países en desarrollo y sean miembros de WISTA International pueden participar con las becas que concede la Asociación.¹

3 El curso se impartirá únicamente en inglés. Constará de ponencias interactivas, talleres, estudios de casos y ejercicios en grupo dirigidos por personal experto en liderazgo marítimo, oratoria, gestión de proyectos y espíritu de equipo. Los principales objetivos del curso son:

- .1 mejorar las competencias de liderazgo de las participantes, incluidas la autoconciencia, la confianza y las aptitudes para la toma de decisiones;

- .2 reforzar la capacidad de las participantes para gestionar eficazmente equipos, proyectos y desafíos organizativos;
 - .3 ofrecer un foro para el intercambio de conocimientos, la creación de redes y la colaboración entre mujeres al frente del sector marítimo; y
 - .4 promover la equidad de género en el liderazgo marítimo, haciendo frente a las barreras que puedan entorpecer el progreso.
- 4 El curso abarcará una serie de temas esenciales. A continuación figuran algunos:
- .1 diseño y gestión de proyectos;
 - .2 pensamiento crítico e incorporación de la perspectiva de género;
 - .3 iniciativa empresarial;
 - .4 pensamiento estratégico;
 - .5 liderazgo;
 - .6 espíritu de equipo;
 - .7 comunicación eficaz;
 - .8 oratoria;
 - .9 *coaching* y mentoría; y
 - .10 promoción y orientación en cuanto a perspectivas de carrera.

5 Las tasas del curso, el alojamiento, los pasajes aéreos de ida y vuelta en clase turista y las comidas durante la semana de formación *in situ* en Malmö estarán cubiertos para las 15 participantes seleccionadas, gracias a la financiación de la OMI. Además, la OMI ofrecerá a cada participante una asignación diaria de 15 dólares para gastos accesorios y 252 dólares para pequeños gastos de salida y llegada. No obstante, las autoridades que designen a las participantes están obligadas a seguir pagando los salarios de las funcionarias que vayan a asistir al curso de formación de la UMM mientras dure este, con el fin de mantener a sus respectivas familias en sus respectivos países de origen.

6 Las participantes se ocuparán por sí mismas de:

- .1 obtener el visado de entrada en Suecia para el componente que se celebrará *in situ*, por cuenta propia y/o de la autoridad o el empleador que las hayan designado; y
- .2 obtener un seguro médico adecuado que sea válido para todos los países en los que puedan permanecer, residir, a los que puedan viajar tanto a la ida como a la vuelta, o por los que puedan transitar, independientemente del propósito o del motivo del viaje o del modo de transporte. Las participantes seleccionadas deberán presentar pruebas documentales del seguro de viaje.

7 Las participantes patrocinadas por la OMI estarán cubiertas, mientras dure su beca, por el seguro del Grupo médico de las Naciones Unidas para becarios de todo el mundo en el que participa la OMI.

8 Las solicitantes deberán dominar la lengua inglesa y poder demostrar esa fluidez al participar en el curso, así como las posibles ventajas del curso para sus respectivos países.

9 Además, se recomienda encarecidamente a las autoridades que designen participantes que se abstengan de presentar solicitudes de graduadas de la Universidad Marítima Mundial (UMM) o del Instituto de Derecho Marítimo Internacional (IMLI) de la OMI, dado que el curso tiene por objeto ofrecer oportunidades de formación en liderazgo a participantes que no se hayan beneficiado anteriormente de actividades educativas en la UMM o el IMLI. Las solicitudes de graduadas que no revelen sus cualificaciones de la UMM y el IMLI no se considerarán válidas, y se podrán eliminar del proceso de selección.

10 Si bien se desea que la distribución geográfica de las participantes sea lo más amplia posible, el número de plazas por país es limitado. Por consiguiente, si se presentan dos o más candidatas de un país, se agradecerá que la autoridad competente indique el orden de prioridad.

11 Se dará preferencia a funcionarias que se encuentren en las primeras etapas o en la mitad de su carrera que demuestren gran potencial de liderazgo, así como a miembros de las asociaciones regionales de mujeres en el sector marítimo (WIMA) establecidas por la OMI.

12 Las solicitudes deberán presentarse utilizando el formulario de solicitud adjunto (anexo 2) y deberán respetarse estrictamente las orientaciones e instrucciones para cumplimentar el formulario de solicitud que figuran adjuntas (anexo 1). Las solicitudes deberán llegar a la UMM, conforme se indica en las orientaciones e instrucciones adjuntas, a más tardar el **25 de abril de 2025**.

13 Las participantes y las autoridades que designen a las participantes deberían tener en cuenta que solo se contactará con las candidatas a las que se haya concedido una beca de la OMI. Se ruega tomar nota de que la OMI no mantendrá correspondencia con las autoridades que presenten las candidaturas ni con las solicitantes en relación con el estado de sus candidaturas.

ANNEX 1

INAUGURAL "MARITIME WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP AND EMPOWERMENT" TRAINING COURSE, MÄLÖ, SWEDEN

Guidance and instructions for completion of the application form

1 Applications for this training course should be submitted to WMU by the nominating Government or organization on behalf of their candidate(s) no later than **25 April 2025**. Applications received after that date may not be considered.

2 Applications for this course must be made using the attached application form, which should be TYPEWRITTEN or completed in BLOCK CAPITALS IN BLACK INK, as follows:

- Part I of the application form must be completed and signed by a duly authorized officer of the nominating Government or organization. This part should be completed after the candidate has completed Part II. The official seal or stamp of the authority nominating the candidate must be affixed to this part; and
- Part II of the application form must be completed and signed by the candidate. This part should include details of previous maritime-related experience, an explanation of the benefits the candidate hopes to derive from the training, and how the candidate will transfer the acquired knowledge to colleagues upon returning to their post. Additionally, the applicant should provide details of any leadership or career development challenges in the maritime sector in which they have a particular interest.

3 The completed application form, a copy of the data page of the candidate's passport (showing, as a minimum, the name of the holder, the passport number, date and place of issue and date of expiry), as well as an official letter confirming the release of the candidate by their employer (should they be selected for the course) should accompany the application and be sent by email to WMU's Professional Development Courses email address: pdc@wmu.se, with a copy to IMO at email address womeninmaritime@imo.org.

4 Applicants who have submitted all the required documents should be aware that, if selected for the course, an assessment of their proficiency in the course language (English) may be undertaken by WMU, via teleconference or telephone, prior to offering a place on the course.

5 Candidates are strongly urged to ensure that their applications are complete in all respects, as incomplete applications may not be considered. WMU/IMO may not accept resubmission of incomplete applications.

6 All dates must be in dd/mm/yyyy format.
