Subject: Informal "Thematic Exchange Day" on 5 June 2025

- The Secretary-General has the honour to invite participation in the forthcoming informal "Thematic Exchange Day" scheduled to take place from 8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. (GMT) on Thursday, 5 June 2025, followed by a cocktail at IMO Headquarters, 4 Albert Embankment, London SE1 7SR. The workshop will be conducted in English without interpretation.
- This event aims to enhance the engagement by Member States in informal discussions, participation and networking, while discussing the new thematic approaches to technical cooperation (TC). The presentations and panel discussions will increase the visibility of technical cooperation results based on success and lessons learned. The day will be organized around the four core themes: Safety, Environment, Security, and Facilitation. Furthermore, the workshop will offer the opportunity to learn more on the best practices to request for technical assistance and to clarify any questions in an interactive exchange. Project exhibits will be displayed throughout the day, allowing participants to meet the project teams and discuss the projects in detail.
- The event will take place in the margins of the seventy-fifth session of the Technical Cooperation Committee. Delegates registered to attend TC 75 using the hybrid capability will be able to participate under the same modality. Please refer to annex I of Circular Letter No.4927.
